Don't use Isidora Sans for larger bodies of text.

Our Logo

Our Archie logo should be used whenever a graphical representation of our brand is needed. It should not be altered in any way. The Archie Design System is the source of truth for the most up to date versions of the logo.



Logo Usage

The combination of the Archie Home Glyph and word mark create the Archie Logo Lockup.

Never use the word mark alone, it should always be accompanied by the Archie Home Glyph.

Never use the logo inline with text, it should always be by itself, with space to breathe.

Space to breathe



Always allow space around the logo. As a guide, use the letter “e” from “Archie” to calculate breathing space.


Exceptions may be made when used in software in constricted spaces such as header bars in software applications, but in general the above guide should stand.

The Archie Home Glyph

The Archie Home Glyph may be used separately as an icon.

It should only be used in places where Archie needs to be represented without the word mark. For example as an app icon or as a favicon that appears in the URL bar in a web browser.

Space to breathe



Always allow space around the glyph. As a guide, use the horizontal space from the letter “r” from “Archie” to calculate breathing space.

Exceptions may be made when used in software in constricted spaces such as favicons in browsers, but in general the above guide should stand.

Light and Dark Backgrounds

Light and dark versions of the logo have been specially designed to work well on their respective backgrounds. Never apply color to the logo itself. Instead use the light and dark versions as provided.
